Title of the best practice: Adoption of a local school for mentoring

Objectives of the practice: Extension of improved facilities for the Schools of local community

Context: The College not only confines its role to impart education to its students but also tries to bring forth the issues faced by them during the early phases of their primary education. A counselling session was conducted with the students of the schools and it was found that most of the students are first generation learners of their respective localities and are facing very tough times in acquiring the quality education.

Practice: The College as part of its social responsibility has adopted a Middle school Mathindoo which is located in a far-flung area & lacks basic facilities for their daily sustenance and acquiring of quality education. The aim is to provide logistic support, sports and laboratory facilities to its students so that some sort of yearning is aroused in their minds regarding their future plans of education. The college with an aim to act as mentor for the adopted school provided a platform to these young students to improve their curricular and co-curricular skills by familiarizing them with novel and advanced methods of learning by providing the ICT based equipment's like computers and sports items. It is also pertinent to mention that on the very first visit to this school, it was found that the school lacks the basic requirement of student furniture even for their elementary class students. It was as such decided by the college advisory committee to help the institute in augmenting this school with basic infrastructure, sports equipment and computers. To provide a little exposure to the students of the said school a picnic was organized for the students of this far-fling school to Srinagar city. In short such collaboration has enhanced the educational outcomes through resource sharing, exposure exchange, access to educational resources and mentorship. It has somehow bridged the educational gap and created supportive networks for the teachers and students of this rural area

Evidence of success:

- **1.** The continuance of the practice is a success in itself and students are getting benefitted by it.
- **2.** Adopting these schools has led to the success by fostering a sense of community, promoting mutual learning and providing valuable resources.
- **3.** College involvement has enhanced educational opportunities for the students, infrastructure and created positive learning environment

Problems encountered:

- 1. Lack of transport facility to carry the students from school to college is a problem.
- 2. Mobilization of funds
- 3. Resource limitation

Practice: The area being hilly is having very limited flat space and there are no playgrounds available in any of the schools or the nearby villages. The college being the only location in the whole area having a good sports infrastructure in terms of playing ground and other necessary sports equipment's . Hence the college playground is utilized by nearby schools and youth of the area to organize different sports activities. Besides using the playground they are getting training from the professional and qualified Physical training instructor of the college which reflects a positive community engagement and sharing of resources. This practice not only benefits the college but also fosters a sense of collaboration and well-being in the surrounding areas. It exemplifies a positive collaboration between the educational institution and the local community. This sharing of resources not only promotes physical activity but also fosters a sense of inclusivity and community well-being. It showcases a commendable effort by the college to contribute positively to the lives of those in the neighbouring villages, creating a mutually beneficial relationship. The college has organized different activities like volley ball, cricket, badminton, shot-put, javelin, discuss throw, high jump and hockey penalty shootout activities with the nearby schools of the area. In short the shared playground serves as a platform for the talent development, encouraging physical activity and identifying individuals with athletic potential. It has resulted in the healthier lifestyle and holistic development of the youth in the nearby area

The proceedings of the daylong event were carried by Dr. Raof Ahmad Bhat, Head Department of Physical Education & Sports of the College.






