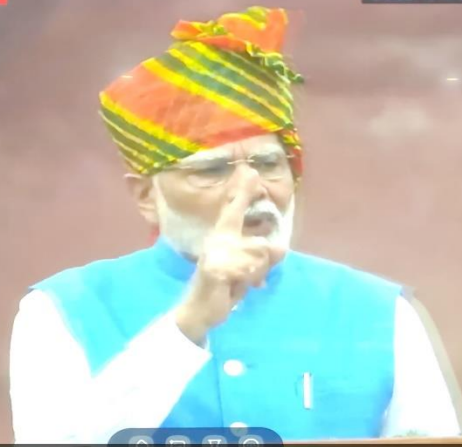

Quiz Competition on Independence of India

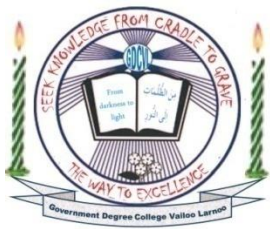
