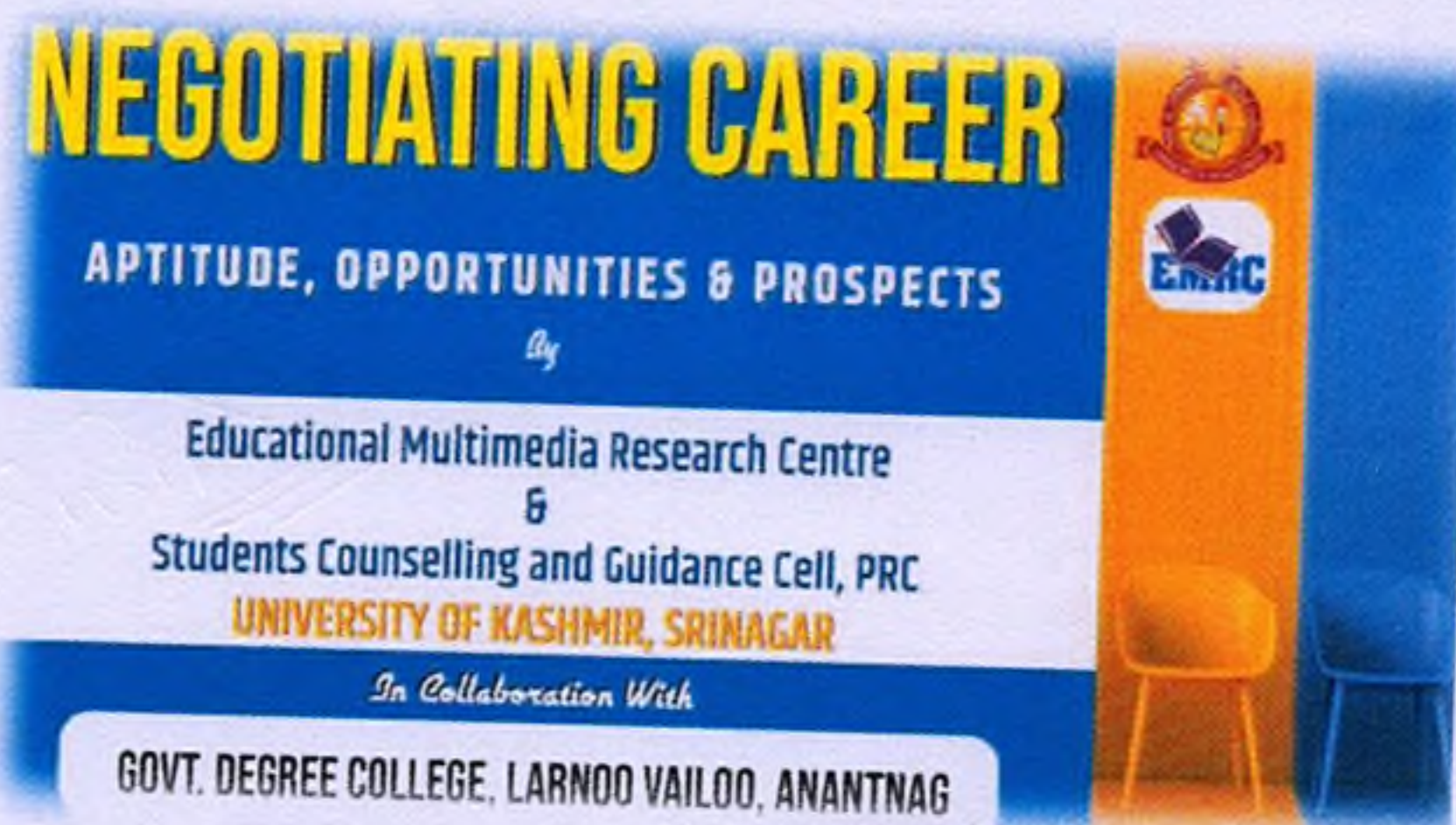
Programme Summary:

The Career Counselling Programme themed "Negotiating Careers - Aptitude, Opportunities & Prospects" was held on 23rd October 2024 at Government Degree College (GDC) Vailoo Larnoo, Anantnag. The event was a collaborative effort between Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMRC), Students Counselling & Guidance Cell (SCGC), Public Relations Centre (PRC) from the University of Kashmir, along with the Career Counselling & Placement Cell (CCPC) and the Debates & Seminar Committee of GDC Vailoo Larnoo. It aimed to provide insightful guidance to undergraduate students regarding career opportunities, online education, and aptitude-based career decisions.

The programme began at 11:00 a.m., with the proceedings coordinated by Prof. Irshad Ahmad Sheikh. The inaugural welcome address was delivered by Dr. Mudasir Altaf Bhat, the in-charge Principal of GDC Larnoo, who warmly welcomed the invited speakers and participants. Session 3: "Careers at KU & Outside"

The third session featured a presentation by Mr. Mir Zubair Rashid, Counsellor at the University of Kashmir, who spoke on the theme "Careers at KU & Outside". Mr. Zubair provided detailed information on the various career options available for students within the University of Kashmir and other institutions of national repute. His presentation covered a wide range of learning opportunities, from undergraduate to postgraduate programs, as well as competitive exams and vocational/skill courses that students can pursue to build their careers.

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
