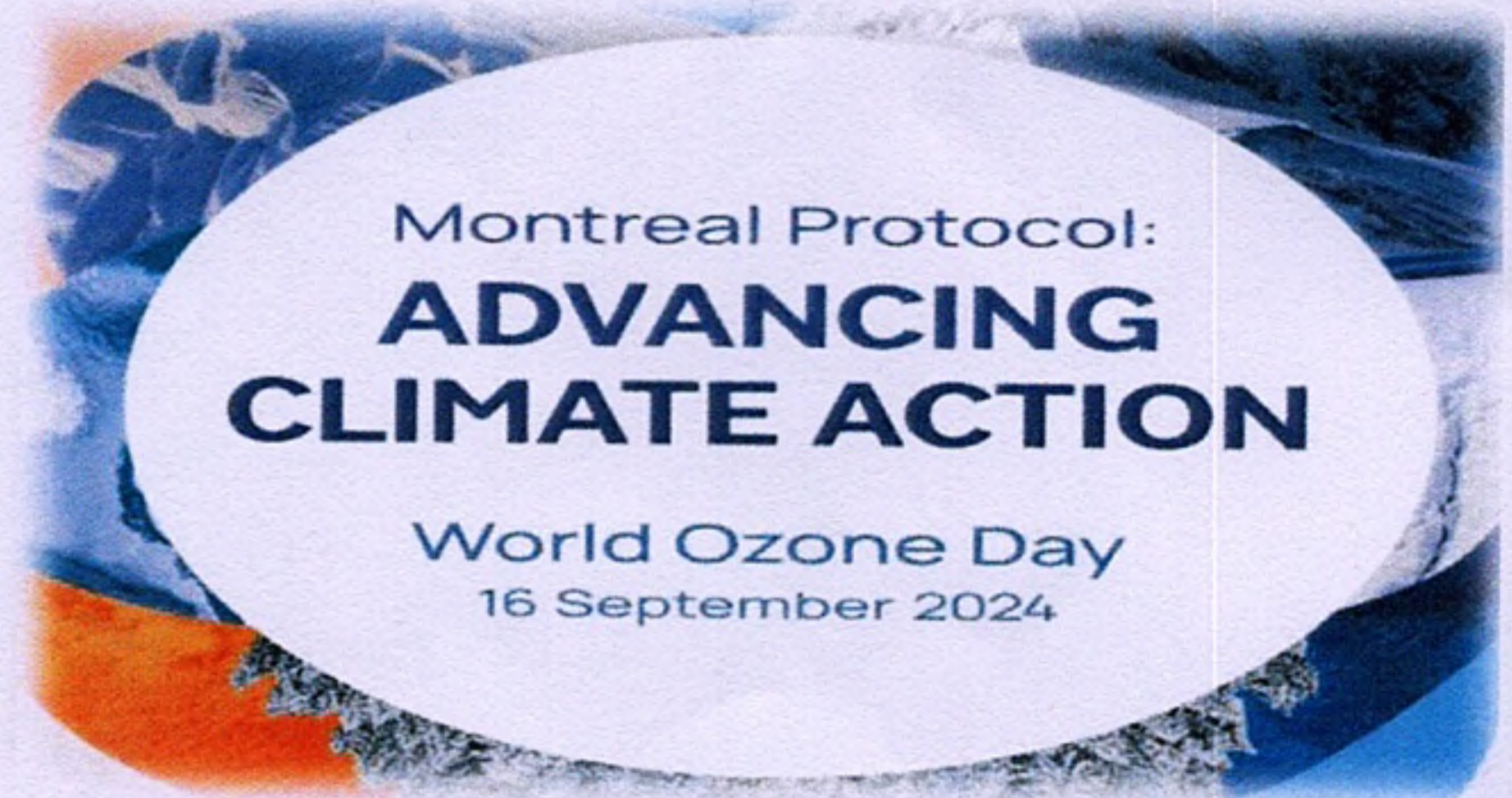
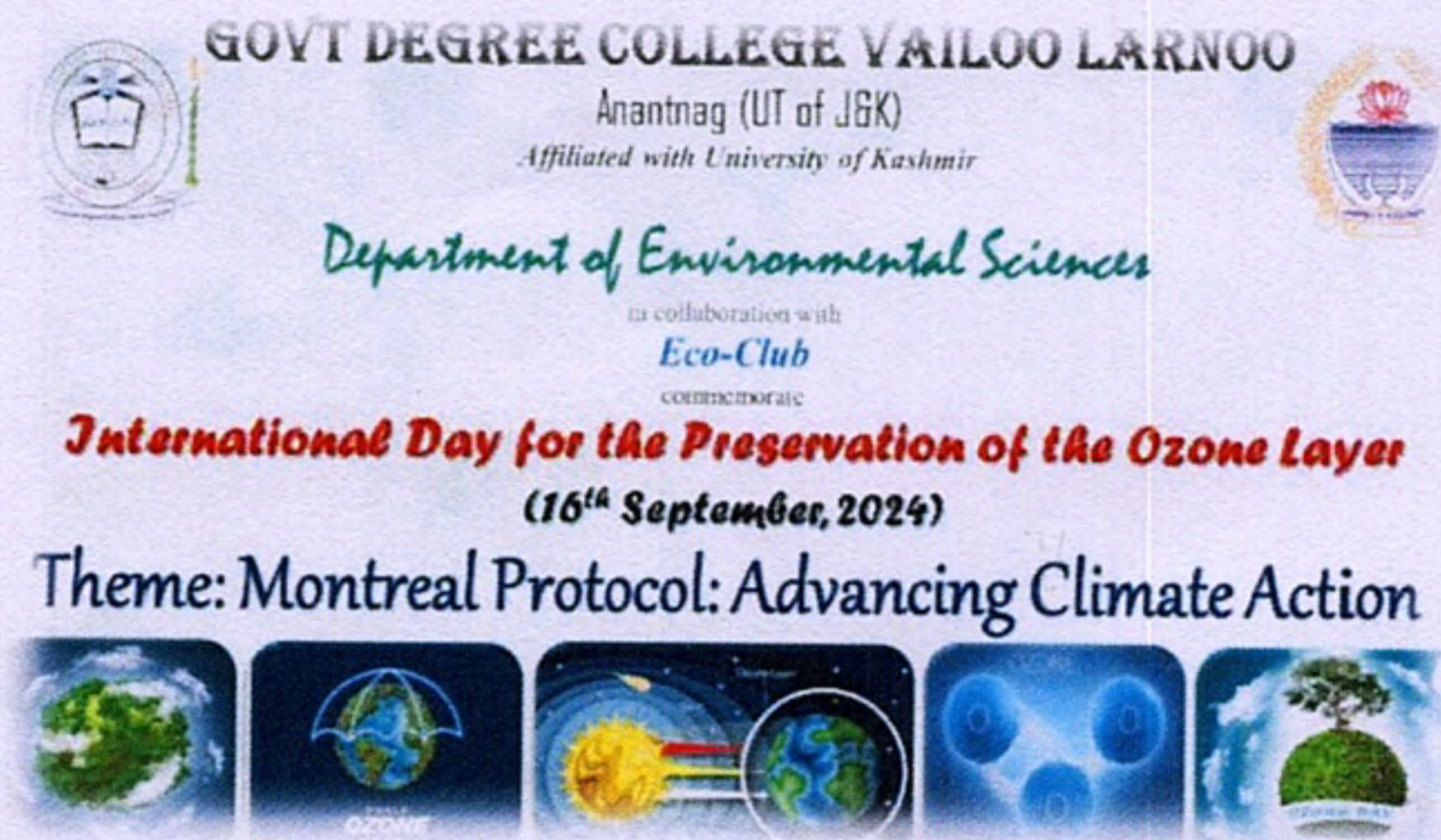
Programme Summary:
