INTRODUCTION

The Electoral Literacy Club (ELC) at Government Degree College Larnoo, in collaboration with NSS wing of the college, operating under the auspices of the Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) Cell in Anantnag, undertook a series of impactful initiatives to promote voter awareness and civic engagement among students and the wider community. These meticulously planned activities had been designed by Nodal Officer SVEEP (Anantnag) to instil a profound sense of responsibility towards democratic participation and foster a culture of informed decision-making, aligning with the broader objectives of promoting electoral literacy and strengthening democratic institutions.







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SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITIES:

1. **Expert Talk on Voting Awareness**

On April 15, 2024, the ELC organized an expert talk on "Awareness Programme on the Importance of Voting & Electoral Processes, with special reference to the Kashmir region" The session, delivered by Syeed Mudasir Mushtaq, the Coordinator of ELC, provided attendees with deep insights into the significance of voting and electoral processes, particularly in the context of the Kashmir region. The session was well-attended and facilitated meaningful discussions among participants, contributing to heightened awareness and understanding of electoral issues.





2. **Mock Election Campaign **

Mock election campaigns were conducted by the students on April 16, 2024, providing a simulated electoral experience for participants. Through this hands-on activity, students gained practical exposure to campaigning and voting processes, fostering a deeper understanding of democratic principles and encouraging active participation in the electoral process.





3. **Drama/Skit on Voting and Democracy**

On April 22, 2024, students showcased a compelling drama/skit highlighting the importance of voting and democracy. This creative expression served as a powerful medium for conveying key messages about civic duty and the transformative potential of active citizenship. The performance resonated with the audience, effectively communicating the significance of electoral participation in shaping the future of the nation.





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
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
4. **Poster/Pamphlet making and Social Media Campaign**

From April 23rd to 25th, 2024, students engaged in poster and pamphlet making activities, producing visually captivating materials to emphasize the importance of voting and democracy. These materials were complemented by a robust social media campaign, leveraging digital platforms to reach a wider audience and stimulate conversations on electoral issues. A rally was organised on 23-04-2024 that marched through the college vicinity to aware the masses regarding the importance of the voting and democracy. A interactive lecture series was organised/delivered by the SVEEP Cell (Anantnag) in which the experts highlighted the role of citizens towards fostering of a better nation, 'India'. They also organised a small quiz, and awarded





the students with certificates for their rich awareness regarding the awareness of voting and democratic setup. The integrated approach effectively amplified the impact of voter awareness efforts, fostering greater engagement and dialogue within the community.









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5. *Digital Storytelling Project**

On April 29, 2024, the students launched digital storytelling projects, creating short videos and multimedia presentations exploring the significance of voting from their unique perspectives. 6. **Voting Pledge Campaign **



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


7. **Voter Awareness Rallies**

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
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8. **Quiz Competitions**


democratic principles. Students actively took part in the quiz, and answered questions precisely, implying that they had a good understanding of voting and electoral processes in India.


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10. **Visit to Sinthan Top**

On May 9, 2024, a visit to Sinthan Top was organized by SDM Kokernag under the SVEEP programme in collaboration Youth Services and Sports (Anantnag) with participants from Government Degree College Vailoo Larnoo and Government Degree College Kokernag. *Prof.* Farooq Ahmad Pandith (Principal – GDC Vailoo Larnoo) along with the faculty members and students of the college participated

in the inaugural function, held at Daksum stop. All the participants then embarked on the trekking-cum-awareness programme. This initiative aimed to raise mass awareness about the importance of voting and democracy among remote communities, underscoring the college's commitment to extending voter education efforts to all corners of the region.
